DEPARTMENT #9

RULES: Only animals owned, fitted and shown by the exhibitor in Junior Department Livestock Divisions are eligible. First three winners may advance to next Showmanship Division.

No Entry Fee

- DIVISION 1: BEEF
- DIVISION 2: DAIRY CATTLE
- DIVISION 3: SWINE
- DIVISION 4: SHEEP
- DIVISION 5: DAIRY GOATS
- DIVISION 6: BOER GOATS

- CLASS:**
1. 4-H Junior
Limited to exhibitors in the 4th & 5th Grades. First three winners may advance to 4-H Intermediate Showmanship Class.
 2. 4-H Intermediate
Limited to exhibitors in the 6th, 7th, & 8th Grades. First three winners may advance to 4-H Advanced Showmanship Class.
 3. 4-H Advanced
Limited to 9th Grade and above. Exhibitor earning 1st place will advance to 4-H Advanced Master Showmanship.
 4. FFA Novice
Limited to FFA students showing a species for the first time during the current school year. This class is not open to FFA students with previous 4-H experience in that species. First three winners may advance to FFA Intermediate Showmanship Class.
 5. FFA Intermediate
Limited to Freshman and Sophomores regardless of experience. First three winners may advance to FFA Advanced Showmanship Class.
 6. FFA Advanced
Limited to 11th Grade & above. Exhibitor earning 1st place will advance to FFA Advanced Master Showmanship.

ADVANCED MASTER SHOWMANSHIP

DO NOT ENTER DEPARTMENT #10

1st through 7th Ribbons Only. Any previous winner of Advanced Master Showmanship at the Chowchilla-Madera County Fair will not be eligible to compete, except 4-H previous winner is eligible to compete in FFA division. Entries in Master Showmanship must have been winners in individual classes of showmanship. All Advanced Showmanship winners must compete in Master Showmanship. In the event an exhibitor wins two specie contests in one division that exhibitor must designate which species they will participate in. It is YOUR responsibility to scratch one (1) hour after completion of Showmanship if you are not able to compete. A form must be signed at the livestock office. This will allow the 2nd place winner eligible to compete.

SMALL ANIMAL MASTER SHOWMANSHIP

DO NOT ENTER

1st through 3rd Ribbons only. First place winners in Senior Rabbit, Avian, and Dog Showmanship. Any previous winner of Small Animal Master Showmanship at the Chowchilla-Madera County Fair will not be eligible to compete. Entries in Master Showmanship must have been winners in individual classes of showmanship. All Advanced Showmanship winners must compete in Master Showmanship. In the event an exhibitor wins two specie contests in one division, that exhibitor must designate which species they will participate in. It is YOUR responsibility to scratch one (1) hour after completion of showmanship if you are not able to compete. A form must be signed at the livestock office. This will allow the 2nd place winner eligible to compete.

PEE WEE SHOWMANSHIP

Open to Juniors 9 yrs of age & under NOT enrolled in 4-H.

Entry forms can be picked up in Livestock Office during fair.

LIMITED TO SHEEP AND GOATS ONLY. All must be tagged with the USDA Scrapie tag to enter the fairgrounds. No late entries.

RULES: All animals must be shown by exhibitor. This division is to be maintained as an exhibition and no animal from the division is to be sold in the sale ring. Entries shall be made on livestock entry forms provided by the fair. The signature of a parent or guardian is required. State and Local rules apply to all entries. Exhibitors who are enrolled in any junior organization for which classes are offered elsewhere are not eligible to enter in this division

DIVISION 1: Pee Wee Showmanship

- CLASS: 1. 3 to 5 years old – Animal exhibited under 50 pounds.
 2. 6 to 9 years old – Animal exhibited under 90 pounds.

4-H & FFA EDUCATIONAL PANEL DISPLAYS – American System of Judging

Rules: Panel should be livestock related. NO more than one entry per species per club. Panel must be no larger than 4x8 feet of plywood or other rigid material. Material must be supplied by club and will be displayed in the Little Theater for the duration of the Fair. Clubs/Chapters may pick up panels on Monday, May 18th between 9 am–6 pm. All panels MUST be designed, constructed and displayed by club or chapter members only. Adults may supervise.
