RULES: NO BOAR SHOW. The exhibitor must have sole ownership of their breeding swine; have them under their care and management, and under the supervision of the organization in which the project will be shown for a minimum of the 30 consecutive days immediately prior to the opening day of the fair. Sows, Senior Yearling or older must have raised a litter of pigs to be eligible for entry. Gilts entered in market or feeder hog division may not be entered in the breeding division or vice-versa. Any violations of this rule will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the fair. **DRAW EAR NOTCHINGS ON ENTRY FORM. DO NOT USE NUMBERS TO IDENTIFY NOTCHES.** NO BOAR CLASSES AVAILABLE.

MARKET HOG SCORECARD

GRADE:

Market Acceptable: U.S. No. 1 and No. 2 hogs of average or greater conformation that are acceptable in leanness, muscularity and production traits.

Not Market Acceptable: Any hog of below average conformation including U.S. No. 3, U.S. No. 4 and utility grade hogs.

Breeds called at scale*

RULES: After weighing, market hogs may be divided by breeds, into weight lots within 215 – 300 pound limitation as desired for convenience in judging, with no maximum weight limit. Exhibitor will be paid up to 275 lbs. Any hog weighing over 300 lbs. will be put into a HEAVYWEIGHT class and will not be eligible for Champion or selling in the Chowchilla-Madera County Livestock Auction. This must be done by 7:00 p.m. on Monday, May 10th. Market Acceptable No. 1 and No. 2 sell.
