### **Scrapies Requirements for Sheep and Goats**

All sheep and goats entering fairs require individual identification. All official identification will be kept on the animals. The official identification may be official USDA individual identification ear tags, premises ear tags or legible premise tattoos (if they include a unique animal number), Scrapie Flock Certification program ear tags, registration tattoos if accompanied by registration papers, or other methods approved by the California Department of Food and Agriculture.

### **REGISTERED PUREBRED BREEDING ANIMALS**

**RULES:** Flock number shall be used to identify all entries. Numbers shall be on regular and practical tags attached to the ear or tattooed in the ear. An exhibitor may not use the same flock number on more than one animal during any consecutive calendar year. Flock numbers and breeder's initials, name or association prefix shall be on regular and practical tags attached to the ear or tattooed in the ear for yearlings and lambs bred by exhibitor. *REGISTRATION NUMBERS MAY NOT BE USED AS FLOCK NUMBERS. LAMBS MUST SHOW LAMB'S TEETH.* The exhibitor must have sole ownership of their breeding sheep, under their care and management, and under the supervision of the organization in which the project will be shown for a minimum of the 30 consecutive days immediately prior to the opening day of the fair.

**RULES:** Each entrant shall provide their own sheep or make arrangements to borrow one. NO RAMS may be shown. Entry is open to all members of 4-H and FFA. Independents must be registered as such with this fair. Entries will be judged on mode of dress selected, which must be appropriate, attractive and lend elegance to the class. Entrants must furnish their own outfit, which must be made either of **100% WOOL**, or a minimum of **70% WOOL** and no more than **30% SYNTHETIC FIBER**.

Entrants must also provide their commentary sheet based on the qualifying event. The commentary must be typed and written in **“THIRD PERSON”** and must be included with the official entry form due by Wednesday, April 14, 2010 by 5 PM. Sheep must be conditioned, fitted and trained to show at halter. Entrant must do all grooming preparation for show. Outfits do not have to be made by the entrant. Rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> place. Lad and Ladies Lead contestant must provide a sample of wool material with entry form. Outfits must be new to this fair.

## SINGLE MARKET LAMBS DEPARTMENT #18

### MARKET LAMB SCORECARD

**GRADE**

Market Ready: USDA Prime or Choice quality with 12<sup>th</sup> rib back fat range .16 - .35 average or greater conformation and cut ability.

Not Market Ready: Good or lower quality grade with 12<sup>th</sup> rib back fat range <.16 or >.35; under finished lambs grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cut ability.

NOTE: Fair may allow for additional grouping system within the Market Ready lambs for sale purposes

**RULES:** After weighing, market lambs may be divided into weight lots within 100 to 145 pound limitation as desired for convenience in judging, with no maximum weight limit. Exhibitor will be paid up to 145 lbs. Breed classification will be determined at scale: Suffolk/Suffolk Cross, Hampshire/Hampshire Cross, Dorset, Specs (Brockel), and AOB. Danish system of judging. The exhibitor must have sole ownership of their market sheep, under the care and management, and under the supervision of the organization in which the project will be shown for a minimum of the 60 days immediately prior to the opening day of the fair. Only market ready lambs will sell.

*Market lambs will be mouthed and classed by breed at scale. Market lambs must have been slick sheared seven (7) days before weigh in. If it appears to have more than 7 days of fleece, you will be asked to shear the lamb and return to scale to weigh in. This must be done by 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, May 11th.*
