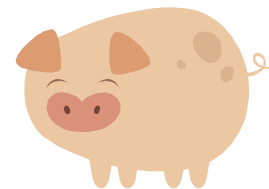


What's Going on in Livestock??

- EXHIBITOR HANDBOOK WILL BE AVAILABLE ONLINE MARCH 1st @ www.chowchillafair.org
- HORSE ENTRIES CLOSE MARCH 31st 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM IN THE MAIN OFFICE.
- ENTRIES (EXCEPT HORSE) CLOSE APRIL 14th 9:00 AM – 5:00PM. Don't forget...You can mail or bring your entries in early into the main office. **Please use separate entry form for breeding and market animals.**
- **BUMP CHECKS:** Bump checks will be mailed directly to the exhibitor if all bumps have been paid in full.
- **SCHEDULE:** Be sure to check out the Livestock Schedule for all details.
- **STATE RULES:** 2010 State Rules are available in the Fair office. If you would like a copy, please come by the Fair office and pick one up! State Rules are also available on the web at www.cdfa.ca.gov/fe
- **PASSES:** A **pass request form is required for all pre-fair purchase of passes.** If you do not send in your request form with your entries you will have to purchase your passes at the gate. **NO passes will be sold through the livestock office.** ALL gates will operate as a paid gate on a 24 hour basis starting Thursday, May 13th at 5:00 PM.
- **SWINE:** Check the Livestock Schedule for show times. FFA will be showing on 5/12 and 4-H will be showing on 5/13. After 4-H is over, ALL Champions will come back for Supreme Champion Drive. Breeding Swine will be showing on 5/13.
- **MARKET ANIMALS:** Ear tags for sheep, swine, and goats will be picked up by advisors and leaders in the Livestock Office starting Wednesday, May 5th After 12:00 PM. It will be the advisors and leaders responsibility to tag ALL of your exhibitor's animals. Animals **must** be tagged before they weigh-in, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- **SHEEP/GOATS:** Scrapie tag number will be taken when exhibitor weighs animal.
- **ALL SPECIES:** There will be NO sift weight for sheep, hogs, goats, and steers. Sheep will be paid up to 145 pounds. Hogs will be paid up to 275 pounds. Goats will be paid up to 120 pounds. Steers will be paid up to 1300 pounds.
- **ALL SPECIES:** Don't forget about entering the Educational Panel Displays for clubs and chapters to show their hard work! Show fair patrons the importance of how to raise a breeding or market animal. The division is right after the showmanship section. *Be creative!!*
- **ALL SPECIES:** When turning in entries, make sure you have the following done: entry is filled out, complete and legible; entry is signed by exhibitor, parent/legal guardian, **AND** leader/advisor; Club or Chapter is on entry form; pass request form filled out by project leader; attach a signed Livestock Agreement; and \$10.00 wristband fee. All of these will lessen the deficiencies and be easier for the exhibitor to check in at fair time!!
- **TRAILER/CAMPER:** \$50 for whole week. Will stay across the street at the School Farm in assigned spaces. You may start arriving on Sunday, May 9th at 9:00 AM.
